Add special salt to the dispenser when the corresponding indicator on the control panel comes on.

Load the dishes

- \rightarrow Remove food leftovers from the dishes
- Place the dishes in the baskets according to loading guidelines.
- It is recommended to load the lower basket first, then the upper basket.


5 Select the wash programme

- ightarrow Open the door, press the Power button Choose a program, the response light will turn on.
- \rightarrow Then close the door, the dishwasher will start its cycle.


- Start your dishwasher 6 Open the dishwasher door. The dishwasher will start a wash programme. Turn off the appliance 7 ightarrow Turn the appliance off using the On/Off button. Remove dishes from the 8 appliance
- When the dishwasher is off, open the door and wait about 15 minutes before removing the dishes. This will also facilitate the drying process. Hot dishes are more susceptible to cracking.


